



## RaceTreads.com Championship Cash Prize

Each year, [RaceTreads.com](#) generously provides cash prizes to the podium finishers of each class in 86 Challenge.

### Competitor Requirements

- Competitors must register for the RaceTreads.com Championship Cash Prize (separate from event registration) through the form available at <https://86challenge.us/documents>
- Competitors must compete in a minimum of five (5) events in a season using approved Yokohama tires purchased from RaceTreads.com or redeemed as part of the Yokohama Tire Contingency program to be eligible
  - Stock Class and Street Class competitors may use GT Radial tires until March 31, 2026 and these events will count toward the 5 event minimum.
- Competitors must satisfy the requirements from *86 Challenge Sponsor Branding Requirements* (see <https://86challenge.us/documents>)

## Yokohama Tire Contingency

The Yokohama Tire Contingency program allows 86 Challenge competitors to earn Tire Points based on their finishing position in each event. Tire Points can be redeemed for Yokohama tires through RaceTreads.com.

### Competitor Requirements

- Competitors must register for the Yokohama Tire Contingency (separate from event registration) through the form available at <https://86challenge.us/documents>
- Competitors only earn Tire Points while using approved Yokohama tires purchased from RaceTreads.com or redeemed as part of the Yokohama Tire Contingency program.
- Competitors must satisfy the requirements from *86 Challenge Sponsor Branding Requirements* (see <https://86challenge.us/documents>)

### Program rules

- Tire Points are awarded based on the finishing position of each event, up to a maximum of 80 points per season (see 86 Challenge rulebook for more information)
- Competitors may redeem **one (1) free tire** for every **ten (10)** Tire Points earned
- Redemptions of less than 10 points are not permitted
- Redemptions can be made at any time during the season and Tire Points are honored until March 31st of the following year
- Eligible products include Yokohama Tire performance products approved by 86 Challenge and RaceTreads.com
- Tires are shipped at no cost to the competitor

## Sponsor Branding Requirements

In order to participate in the [RaceTreads.com](http://RaceTreads.com) Championship Cash Prize and/or Yokohama Tire Contingency program, competitors must display decals on their cars in each event, as described below. Decals are distributed by the 86 Challenge organizers at each event.

Ref.	Brand	Location	Description
1	Yokohama	1x Front Bumper	Center the decal horizontally with the manufacturer badge and align it vertically between the badge and the hood. The decal should be horizontal to the ground.
2	Yokohama	2x Rear Bumper	Align the edge of the decal closest to the centerline of the vehicle with the inside corner of the tail lamp. The decal should be horizontal to the ground.
3	Yokohama	2x Front Fenders	Align the edge of the decal closest to the front of the vehicle with the centerline of the front wheel hub. Center the decal vertically within the flattest available area on the front fender. The decal should be horizontal to the ground.
4	RaceTreads	2x Rear Fenders	Align the edge of the decal closest to the rear of the vehicle with the centerline of the rear wheel hub. Center the decal vertically within the flattest available area on the rear fender. The decal should be horizontal to the ground.
